Risk management activity documentation must be submitted at least six weeks prior to your policy renewal date to ensure credit on your next policy premium. The RM&PSI Education Programs

Live Audio Programs

These programs provide an inexpensive and convenient way to hear experts address risk management topics. We bring nationally recognized speakers to you, with no limits on the number of participants. Handouts and question and answer sessions are also included.

Premium Credit: up to 5 percent (2.5 percent for every two hours)

Live Educational Programs

Risk management experts and consultants will customize training and educational programs to meet your needs. Programs can be presented to your board, administration, medical staff and other members on a wide range of risk management topics.

Premium Credit: up to 5 percent (2.5 percent for every two hours)

Non-RM&PSI Educational Programs

Physician attendance at a risk management program (other than through The RM&PSI) may be eligible for credit. Certificate of attendance, objectives and handouts must be submitted to The RM&PSI for approval. (Prior approval is recommended, as all programs will not meet requirements.)

Premium Credit: up to 5 percent (2.5 percent for every two hours)

Office Staff Participation in Non-RM&PSI Risk Management Education

Credits are earned by showing evidence of staff participation in risk management education (two-hour minimum). Participants must complete a written evaluation of how the education will improve the practice or behavior toward risk reduction or performance improvement, e.g., policy development/enhancement, staff training, chart review procedure. Certificate of attendance, objectives, handouts and written evaluation must be submitted to The RM&PSI for approval.

Premium Credit: 2.5 percent

Physician and Office Staff Education CDs

A simple and inexpensive way to hear experts address risk management topics from the comfort of your home, office or car. A post-conference quiz and evaluation form are included with each CD.

Premium Credit: up to 5 percent (2.5 percent for every two hours)

Electronic Medical Records

Electronic Medical Records (EMR) systems contribute to reduced physician risk through consistent documentation, improved follow-up procedures, increased security, and disaster recovery capabilities. Qualifying systems must be operable for a minimum of one year with at least 75 percent of the group members using the EMR, and the system must be certified by the Certification Commission for Healthcare Information Technology.

Premium Credit: 5 percent for the first year, subsequent annual credits of 2.5 percent

E-prescribing

E-prescribing eliminates illegible hand-written prescriptions and provides an alert system to prevent medication errors that result due to inadequate access to current drug reference information. This system increases patient compliance and patient convenience, and improves formulary adherence.

Premium Credit: 5 percent for the first year, subsequent annual credits of 2.5 percent

Picture Archiving Communication Systems

Picture Archiving Communication Systems (PACS) improves quality and safety by improving timeliness of care and treatment, enhancing accuracy, and improving access to vital patient information.

Premium Credit: 5 percent for the first year, subsequent annual credits of 2.5 percent

Physician Office Assessment and Evaluation

Physician Office Assessment and Risk Management Plan

Conducted on-site by a risk management expert, this assessment includes office review, medical record and procedure review, and staff interviews. Assessment results are provided in a detailed report, which includes performance improvement, risk reduction opportunities and implementation methods. The report also includes an action plan on CD-Rom.

Premium Credit: 5 percent

Physician Office Post-assessment Review

A risk management expert will conduct a post-assessment review of the high-priority areas six months after the Physician Office Assessment and Risk Management Plan to evaluate implementation success.

Premium Credit: 2.5 percent

The Risk Management and Patient Safety Institute Medical Office Self-evaluation

This self-evaluation is conducted by various office staff and physicians in the practice. The tool utilizes responses to evaluate the risk management program.

Premium Credit: 5 percent

Advanced Practice Strategies (APS) Perinatal Safety Curriculum

The APS Perinatal Safety Curriculum has been shown to improve OB safety by teaching up-to-date concepts of fetal assessment and monitoring, management of shoulder dystocia and operative vaginal delivery. Policyholders that complete the 18-hour course are eligible to receive credits.

Premium Credit: 5 percent credit (each year) for two consecutive years

Instant E-mails

Instant E-mails are published regularly throughout the year, by The RM&PSI on various risk management and patient safety practices. Complete four post tests for premium credit.

Premium Credit: up to 5 percent (1.25 percent for completing four post tests)

Physician Practice Risk Management Manual

This resource offers guidance and tools to the physician practice in key risk management areas. Physicians are eligible to receive a credit by completing exams from Part II of the manual. Four exams are available based on a variety of risk management topics.
